GUIDELINES TO OBTAIN PERMISSION FOR BOW HUNTERS TO HUNT DEER/TURKEY ON PRIVATE PROPERTY

1. **PROPERTY OWNER** must write a letter to the Police Chief, explaining reason(s) why they would like to eliminate deer on their property. Requests will be reviewed, case by case, to determine if the property is safe for hunting.
2. Letter should be directed to: Chief of Police, Sioux City Police Department, 601 Douglas Street, Sioux City, IA 51101.
3. Letter should detail:
 - Reason(s) the property owner wishes to allow deer hunting on his property;
 - Names of hunters the property owner is allowing to hunt;
 - Whether the property owner intends to hunt;
 - Address and/or property description where hunting will be done;
 - Day telephone number of property owner so they can be reached when agreement is ready to sign.
4. The agreement has restrictions that must be agreed to. Also, the agreement indemnifies and holds harmless City of Sioux City from any and all claims arising from discharge of arrows under the permit. Office hours are Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
5. Once the property owner has signed the agreement, the property owner will be given a copy of the agreement, to retain in their possession, in case any officials question the permission. The owner will also be given enough copies for the other hunter(s), if any, for them to carry with them while hunting.
6. **ALL STATE HUNTING LAWS APPLY! This agreement is permission to hunt with bow and arrows within City limits only.**
